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Willard H. DaSilva,* senior member of the “AV”-rated DaSilva & Hilowitz LLP, was a veteran matrimonial law practitioner in New City, New York. He was one of fewer than 100 attorneys in the United States invited to be a Diplomat of the American College of Family Trial Lawyers. His biography appears in *Who’s Who in America*, and for more than 25 years he has been listed in *The Best Lawyers in America*. He has been listed in *New York Magazine’s Best Lawyers in the New York Metropolitan Area* and in the *New York Times* as a “Super Lawyer.” He was a past President of the American Academy of Matrimonial Lawyers, New York Chapter, and editor emeritus of the ABA’s *Family Advocate* magazine; editor emeritus of the New York State Bar Association *Journal*; Chairman of the Board of Editors of the nationally published *Matrimonial Strategist*; and author of *New York Matrimonial Practice*, published by Thomson Reuters-West. He was a former Council Member of the American Bar Association’s Section of Family Law, a Master and Past President of the New York Family Law American Inn of Court, a former member of the New York State Bar Association’s House of Delegates, and past Chair of the Association’s General Practice Section. His extensive lecturing schedule to judges and lawyers included seminars sponsored by bar associations and civic organizations throughout the United States, Canada and Europe.

Mr. DaSilva, a *magna cum laude* graduate of New York University and a member of Phi Beta Kappa, received his law degree at Columbia University Law School. He has been widely quoted in the *New York Times*, *Newsday*, *USA Today*, *Newsweek*, *U.S. News & World Report* and the *New York Law Journal*, which has referred to him as the “Dean of Matrimonial Lawyers.” He also appeared on national network and syndicated television and radio programs and “talk” shows.
