Jennifer Stromer-Galley (Ph.D., University of Pennsylvania, 2002) is Professor and Director of the Center for Computational and Data Science in the School of Information Studies at Syracuse University. Her research examines human interaction with and through digital media. She has been PI or Co-PI on federally funded and corporate grants of over \$12 million to study deliberation, decision-making, misinformation, and cognitive biases. She has published over fifty journal articles, proceedings, and book chapters, and is author of Presidential Campaigning in the Internet Age (2nd ed., Oxford University Press).
