An accomplished classroom teacher, Professor Gregory is a nationally recognized authority in the field of family and matrimonial law. He is a former Chair of the Section on Minority Groups and of the Section on Family and Juvenile Law of the Association of American Law Schools. An elected member of the American Law Institute, Professor Gregory served as an Adviser for the Institute's *Principles of the Law of Family Dissolution: Analysis and Recommendations*. He is a member of the Board of Editors of the *Family Law Quarterly*, a Fellow of the American Bar Foundation, and a former Chair of the Matrimonial Law Committee of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York. Professor Gregory is Vice Chair of the National Center for Law and Economic Justice, a national welfare advocacy organization.

Professor Gregory's writings include *The Law of Equitable Distribution, Understanding Family Law* (with Swisher and Wolf), and *Property Division in Divorce Proceedings: A Fifty State Guide* (with Richards and Wolf), together with several law review articles that address family law, constitutional law, and juvenile justice issues. He is a member of the National Writers Union, UAW Local 1981/AFL-CIO.
