

## FAQs for the Conference:

### Getting there:

- Danfords Conference Center is located at 25 East Broadway, Port Jefferson, NY 11777
- Many major highways are available to get you to Long Island. Port Jefferson is on the North Shore. We encourage carpooling.
- If you are driving from upstate or New England, you may want to look at going to Bridgeport, CT, and taking the ferry from there to Port Jefferson (<http://www.88844ferry.com>). The ferry dock is immediately adjacent to Danfords on the Long Island side. We have a special rate for walk-ons - \$13 roundtrip. A parking garage in Bridgeport charges \$10 a day, and it is 1.5 blocks from the ferry dock. If you think you would like to do this, please email me and I'll send specifics.  
If you want to take your car across, it is \$53 each way. You can buy tickets online, but all passengers and drivers must go to the Purser's Window once onboard to check-in. (Please note: as you drive off the ferry, you'll see Danfords on your left -- but you can only turn right! You'll need to go around the block and approach Danfords from the east.)
- LIRR: service to Port Jefferson Station
- Air: MacArthur Airport, Islip (20 mi. from Danfords) – US Airways & Southwest; or the NYC Metro Airports

### The Conference Center:

- Some sleeping rooms at Danfords are second floor walkups. If you need an ADA compliant room, you must notify us as soon as possible, or if you would prefer a first floor room, please let us know.
- Danfords Conference Center is located at 25 East Broadway, Port Jefferson, NY 11777. If you are staying at the hotel, the registration desk is on the left as you go in the driveway. You can park and get registered and get a parking pass. Mention you are with the conference and the pass will be added to our master bill – free for you!
- If you are not staying at Danfords, there is ample public parking on the street and in the municipal lots. Metered parking is 50 cents an hour and street parking is free. Click here to learn more: <http://www.portjeff.com/village-information/metered-parking/>

- Breakfasts and the Wednesday evening reception will be in the Ballroom, over the Main Lobby.  
Both Thursday and Friday lunches, and Thursday evening dinner & keynote, will be held in the Sail Loft Room of the Port Jefferson Village Center, which is the large red building adjacent to Danfords (on the right of Danfords if you're looking at the harbor).
- All twenty-two, 90-minute sessions and our Conference Registration will be at Danfords.

### At the Conference:

- The LYC Registration tables will be in the Bayles/Willse Lobby throughout the conference, starting at 4 pm on Wednesday. Your selected sessions list and all your registration materials will be waiting for you there. - Various local attractions and groups have left information for you about their offerings. We will have a literature sharing table at registration throughout the conference. Some of our presenters will leave materials there to share.

**Meals:**

- Depending on your personal selections when you registered, you may be dining at the conference.
- Wednesday's Reception in the Ballroom, 7-9 pm, will include hors d'oeuvres and complimentary beer and wine. The downstairs Wave Lounge will offer live music should you wish to extend your evening past 9 p.m.
- Breakfasts on both Thursday and Friday, 7 – 8:30 am, will also be in the Ballroom. A hot and cold buffet will be served.
- Lunch on Thursday, 12:15 – 1:15, will be in the Village Center, adjacent to the hotel. A buffet of salads, chicken, pork and pasta entrees and assorted desserts. Friday's lunch will feature deli style selections as we have drawings for our large stash of giveaway items to send you off on your weekend.
- Dinner on Thursday will start with a reception hour from 6-7 pm at the Village Center. Dinner will begin at 7, with a buffet featuring prime rib, salmon and pasta. We will have opening remarks before dining, enjoy the beautiful view from the Sail Loft as we dine, and once dessert and coffee are served, we will begin the presentation by Linda Monk, J.D., "Sunshine Patriots and the Rule of Law."
