

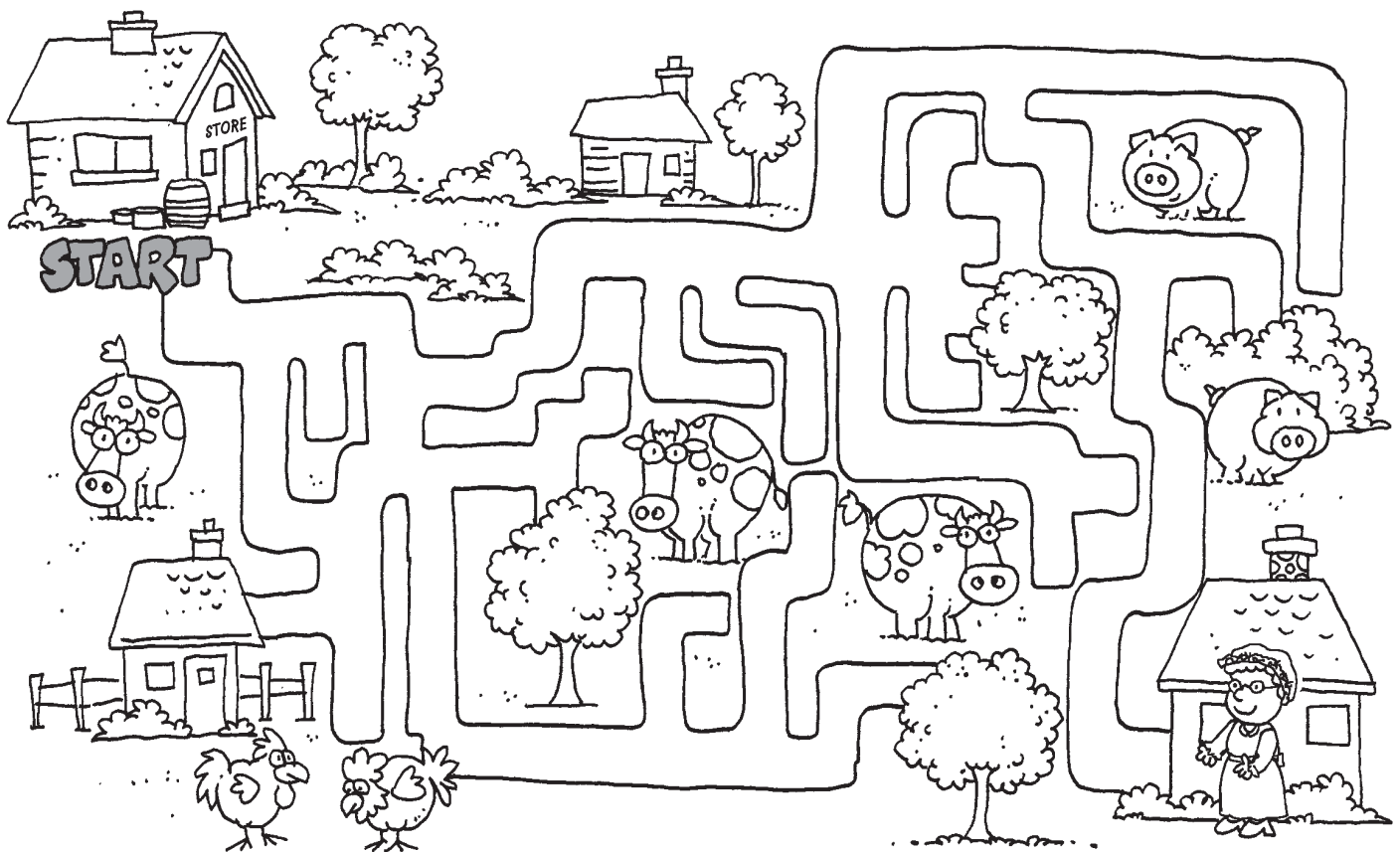
An A-maze-ing Man
