

## **L.Y.C / PROJECT P.A.T.C.H. Summer Institute Credit Options**

All participants in the 2009 Summer Institute are eligible for a certificate verifying completion of our program which can be used by your district to award up to 2 in-service credits. These credits are awarded at the discretion of your district.

Participants may also select the “**Graduate Credit**” option. This is not required. This is offered as a service to applicants pursuing graduate study. This year, we have two courses approved by SUNY Stony Brook’s School of Professional Development that are open for enrollment. These courses require completion of the Summer Institute as a “pre-requisite” for graduate credit, with the remainder of the course work completed online with the instructor over the summer. Participants may not earn both in-service and graduate credit.

### **Graduate Credit Option A**

#### **CEE 519: Building Effective Schools: Practices that Support Student Achievement (3 Credits)**

*Description- This overview of the characteristics of effective schools will guide a discussion of school classroom practices which promote learning. Classroom practices will focus on planning, organizing and delivering effective instruction, while school practices will examine the roles, responsibilities and significance of stakeholders with respect to school improvement.*

### **Graduate Credit Option B (NEW OFFERING)**

#### **CEE 571 - Ethics and Values: Integrating Character Education (3 credits)**

*This course will focus on developing moral values in educational settings. Topics such as trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, justice, fairness, caring, civic virtue and citizenship will be addressed. The objective will be to suggest techniques for integration of these virtues as functioning priorities in our society.*

**Please follow these instructions to secure a space in CEE 519 or CEE 571:**

Complete the material from the SUNY registration link and return it to the P.A.T.C.H. office so it is received by **June 12th** along with your check in the amount of \$725.00 payable to “**NYSBA / LYC.**” If opting for graduate credit, the SUNY Registration Form must be returned in addition to the “2009 Summer Institute OFFICIAL REGISTRATION FORM.” The \$30 Summer Institute Registration Fee is included in the \$725 payable to “NYSBA / LYC.” (\$695 tuition plus \$30 Registration Fee = \$725) Note that the tuition fee and the registration fee are non-refundable. This SUNY courses above are contract course offered through SUNY Stony Brook’s School of Professional Development. Stony Brook will bill the New York State Bar Association for your participation in this course. At the conclusion of the course, you will need to order a transcript from SUNY Stony Brook to file with your district Human Resources / Personnel Office. For purposes of your transcript, there is no distinction between an off campus contract course and a graduate course offered on campus. Seats are limited. First come – first served.
