Bruce D. Feldman is an Assistant Attorney General and Special Counsel in the Office of New

York State Attorney General Eric T. Schneiderman. His practice focuses on contract litigation in the New York State Supreme Court and Court of Claims, principally in the areas of architectural design and construction, and on issues pertaining to access to governmental records. Mr. Feldman served for twelve years as the Assistant Attorney General in Charge of the Litigation Bureau (in Albany) for two Attorneys General, defending the State of New York, its agencies and employees in a broad range of litigation in State and Federal courts.

From 2007 - 2011, Mr. Feldman served as Chief Counsel to the New York State Department of Transportation and Director of the Department's Division of Legal Affairs, providing policy guidance and legal counsel in areas affecting the development, financing and delivery of New York's multi-billion dollar transportation program.

Mr. Feldman graduated from Northwestern University with Highest Distinction and from Boston University School of Law. Born and raised in Haverhill, Massachusetts, he is a member of Congregation Gates of Heaven, where he has served as Vice President of the
