Frederick J. Marshall is a justice of the Erie County Supreme Court in the 8th Judicial District of New York. He was elected to this position in 2001.[1] He was re-elected on November 4, 2014, for a term that expires on December 31, 2028

Marshall began his career in 1980 as a self-employed attorney with the firm of *Kobis and Marshall*. He worked in this capacity through 2000. He also worked as an Aurora Town prosecutor from 1984 to 1988 and then as an Erie County legislator from 1989 to 2000. In 2001, he was elected to the supreme court.

Marshall received his B.A. from the State University of New York at Buffalo in 1976 and his J.D. from SUNY at Buffalo School of Law in 1979.
