Dr. Xiao is an ACTAR Accredited Traffic Accident Reconstructionist and a Certified Playground Safety Inspector.

Dr. Xiao's prior experience in medical school and hospital included simulating rear-end vehicle collisions with cadaver and determining injury potential/causation. He has also helped neurosurgeon determine the mechanical strength of spinal tissue to choose the proper surgical instrumentation. He was part of the rehabilitation treatment program for spinal cord injured patients. He has published peer-reviewed journal papers and presented at numerous national/international science conferences. Dr. Xiao has testified in court and depositions.
