How to Enter:

- 1.) **Eligible articles** must be written by a currently-enrolled or graduating student at a New York State Law School or by a New York State resident at any ABA-accredited law school outside of New York State.
- 2.) **Eligible papers** include notes, comments and article and should generally be 20-30 pages in length, with footnotes. In no event may papers exceed 50 pages, with footnotes.
- 3.) **Eligible papers** may address any topic of general interest to the antitrust law community, including topics relating to civil and criminal antitrust law, competition policy, consumer protection and international competition law.
- 4.) Jointly prepared papers are **not eligible**.
- 5.) Go to the Antitrust Section on the NYSBA website and click on the "Young Lawyers and Law Students" section and download an Entry Form. Mail three copies of the paper, along with a completed Entry Form, by April 30, 2014 to:
