For the past 22 years, the New York State Bar Association through the Elder Law and Special Needs Section has sponsored and promoted its Mitchell Rabbino National Healthcare Decisions Day to inform the public about advanced directives. We are writing to encourage section members to participate in one of the programs to be held **on or after** *April 16*, 2017.

The Programs usually last between forty-five minutes and one hour. As a speaker, you will provide attendees with information on healthcare and financial decision making, guardianship issues, wills and probate. Specific issues include:

- The purposes of the power of attorney and health care proxy and how they differ.

Last year, there were about 70 programs at community facilities, senior centers, libraries and hospitals. We hope to increase the number of programs this year and educate even more New Yorkers on these important issues.
