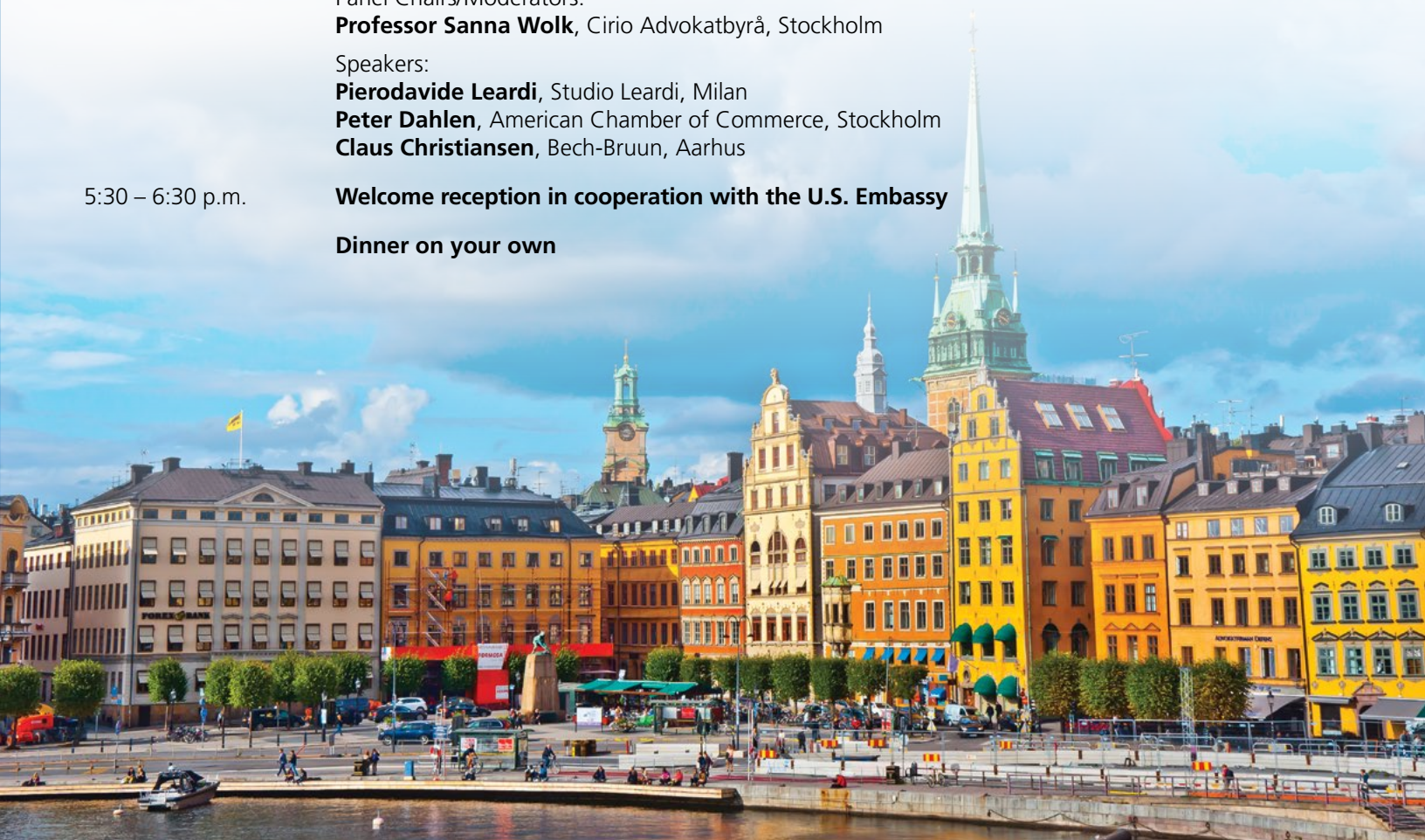

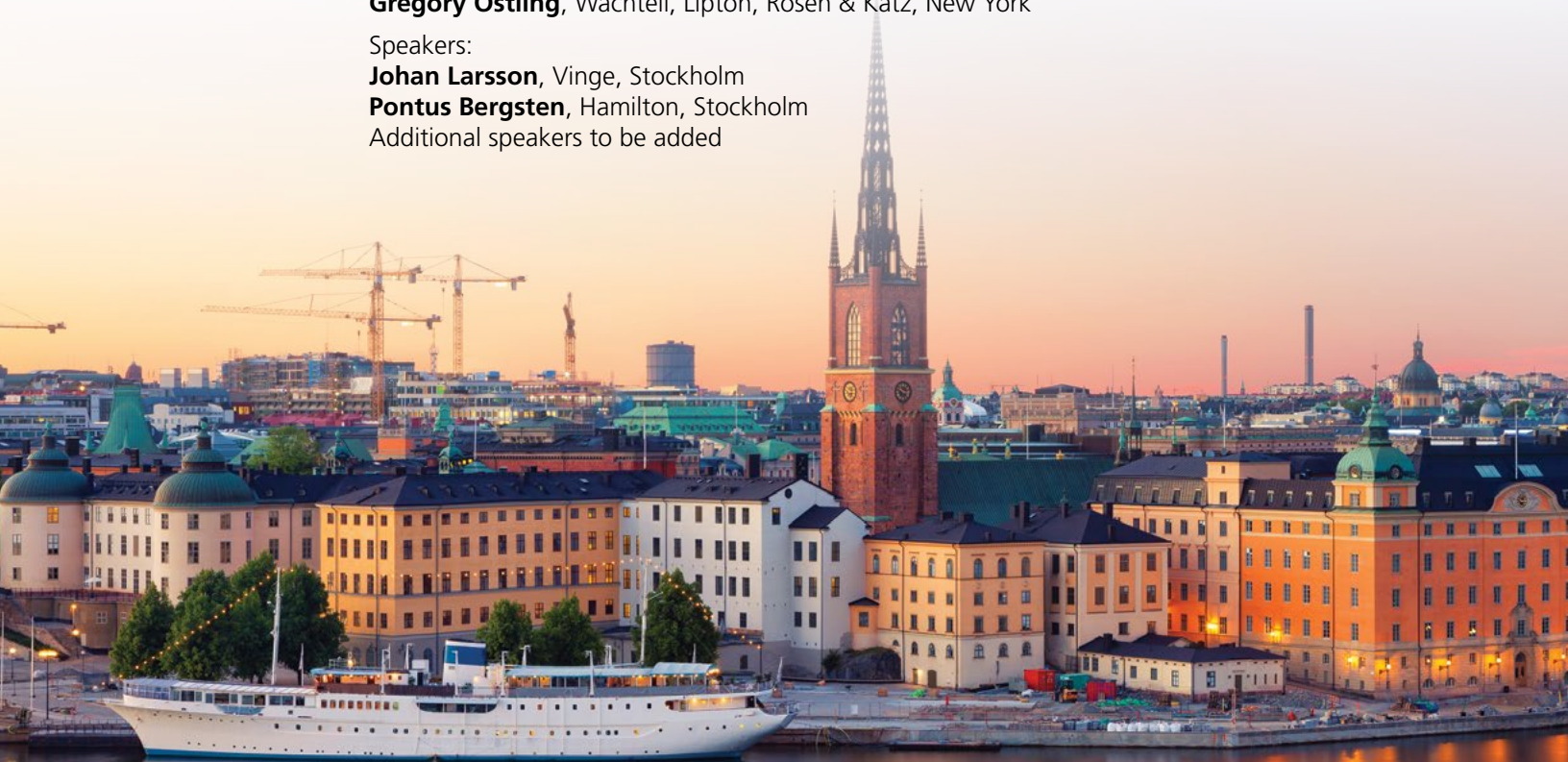

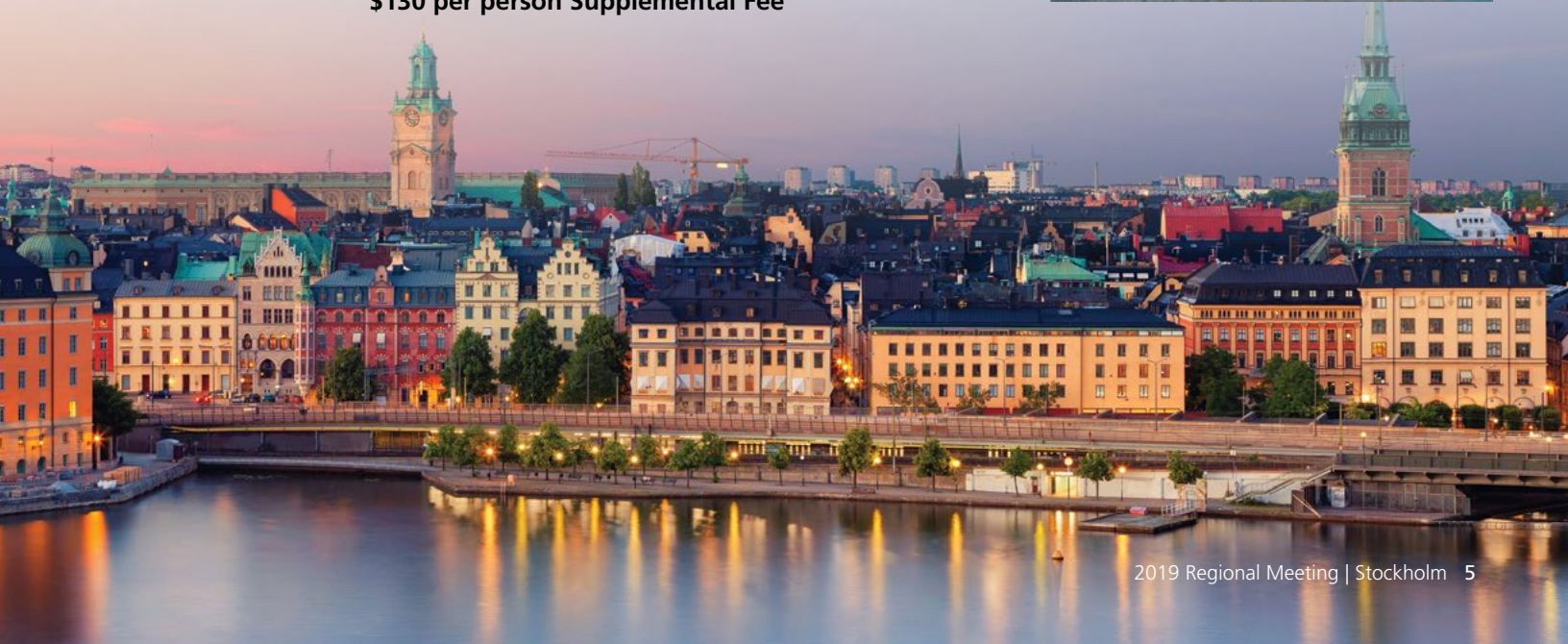
National Museum, Södra Blasieholmshamnen, Stockholm (opposite the Royal Palace)
