

**HYDE HALL** - Hyde Hall at the north end of Otsego Lake, adjacent to Glimmerglass State Park, represents an extraordinary vision of 19<sup>th</sup>-century Anglo-American culture and the establishment of vast agricultural estates in the early years of the American republic. Built by George Clarke (1768-1835), the house is considered one of the finest examples of the neoclassical country house in the United States.

It was built by the village founder, Judge William Cooper, in 1786 to serve as a blacksmith shop for the infant settlement. **HERKIMER DIAMOND MINE** – Go mining at the Herkimer Diamond mines in nearby Herkimer. Herkimer Diamonds are beautiful double-terminated quartz crystals found in Herkimer, New York. Incredibly, these phenomenal gemstones are close to five hundred million years old. The crystals are magnificent works of nature, found in the rock, having a diamond-like geometrical shape.
