hen attorneys do pro bono service, their lives become richer. They have the satisfaction of knowing that, because they volunteer, people's lives are affected, measurably, for the better. And they have the opportunity to meet other attorneys in a volunteer setting, colleagues they otherwise may not have met. So do it for selfish reasons and to help others.

There are lots of opportunities to volunteer, many levels of commitment and many ways to do pro bono. You could take on and litigate an entire case from scratch; you could work on an appeal; or you could serve in a clinic setting, answering questions and assisting with legal documents.

Your firm may sponsor pro bono work – many do. Some of the NYSBA Sections partner with providers or sponsor clinics on their own.

You have so many options. There are more people in need of civil legal help than there are lawyers. Start where you are comfortable – landlord-tenant; domestic violence, divorce and family law; tax; intellectual property and copyright; loss of government services; immigration; veterans; civil rights – then branch out. Legal service providers offer training; so do many bar associations, including ours. Some lawyers have found new fields of law through their volunteer work.

Even if you are really busy, there are opportunities. And we're working to create more opportunities by partner-

ing with legal service providers to find ways to make pro bono work easier, because we don't want you to miss out.

Attorneys are highly skilled, highly educated professionals. Take the opportunity to do something outside of your daily practice and expand your skills. Pro bono can help you. You can help others. And you will reap the almostimmediate reward of having assisted a real person, who otherwise might not have had help.

We applaud all who serve, and especially those NYSBA members who provide at least 50 hours of pro bono service and earn Empire State Counsel status. Make sure to read the stories of those who have served and their comments about their volunteer experience. You will be inspired and moved to help. Enjoy their stories, then go out and do the public good.

"Equal justice under law is not merely a caption on the facade of the Supreme Court building, it is perhaps the most inspiring ideal of our society. It is one of the ends for which our entire legal system exists . . . it is fundamental that justice should be the same, in substance and availability, without regard to economic status." -- Supreme Court Justice Lewis Powell, Jr., in an address to the ABA Annual Meeting, 1976.

As attorneys we have an obligation, individually and collectively, to use the strength of our voices to raise awareness of injustice in our society and, more important, to do something about it.

The Brennan Center for Justice at the New York University School of Law has estimated that 80% of low-income people nationwide have difficulty obtaining legal representation or otherwise accessing the civil court system to protect their property, their family or their livelihood. The good news is that from a peak of 2.3 million in 2010 the number of unrepresented New York civil litigants has been reduced by one-half million in 2014.

This reduction is due in no small part to the assistance of New York's network of professional civil legal services providers and volunteer lawyers. But that means that 1.8 million civil litigants entered the New York court system without the benefit of attorney representation.

Working in partnership with the New York Bar Foundation, we have created a joint task force with members from both the Foundation and the New York State Bar Association to raise additional resources to support these initiatives. This task force, led by Hon. Barry Kamins and Marion Hancock Fish, has proposed ways to attract funding beyond that already allocated to pro bono providers, to further our efforts to bridge the justice gap in New York.

We have led the call for an Albany-based statewide Center for Justice to focus on coordinating, enhancing and enlarging the current statewide pro bono network of providers and resources. By providing easily accessible technology and tools to reduce some of the current obstructions that prevent potential pro bono volunteers from contributing their time and talents, we can increase the number of volunteer opportunities, assist an even greater number of indigent New Yorkers,


and significantly increase the pool of probono volunteers across the state.

A truly statewide effort will help narrow the justice gap. Our Association can take the lead by coordinating our network of New York civil legal service providers, the Office of Court Administration, and private contributors, to build a statewide database where pro bono volunteers can access and sign up for clinics and other pro bono volunteer opportunities in their local communities.

We are moving forward on our partnership with the American Bar Association to offer NY.freelegalanswers.org, a webbased pro bono system where attorneyvolunteers can answer legal questions from indigent New Yorkers.

Attorneys are held to a higher standard, and that is how it should be. Pro bono service is good for our community, good for lawyers, and good for our bar association. When justice is served for the poorest among us, we are all served for the better.

Willkie litigation partner Mary Eaton has years of experience reflecting her unflagging devotion to both pro bono and public service matters. Ms. Eaton's commitment to pro bono includes her tireless efforts on behalf of low-income New Yorkers, the LGBT community and others.

Ms. Eaton has devoted hundreds of hours advocating for low-income transgender men and women's access to healthcare benefits. In a monumental case, a Willkie team led by Ms. Eaton, along with The Legal Aid Society and the Sylvia Rivera Law Project, sued the NYS Department of Health in Federal Court on behalf of a class of transgender Medicaid recipients diagnosed with gender dysphoria ("GD"), seeking to overturn a NYS regulation that excluded Medicaid coverage for transgender-related healthcare (Cruz v. Zucker). The suit has resulted in an amendment to the regulation that now provides coverage for treatment for many low-income New Yorkers suffering from GD. The Willkie team, led by Ms. Eaton, continues to pursue the suit to overturn the regulation's remaining barriers to Medicaid coverage, recently defeating the State's attempt to dismiss the complaint in an opinion dated July 29, 2015.

Ms. Eaton, along with other Willkie attorneys, served as counsel for 92 plaintiffs as Amici Curiae in the same-sex marriage case from the Sixth Circuit decided in June 2015 by the United States Supreme Court, Obergefell, et al. v. Hodges, et al. Ms. Eaton had a leading role in the brief, which addressed the Sixth Circuit's question of "who decides" whether the laws denying marriage to same-sex couples unjustifiably treat amici and other gay men and lesbians as second-class citizens. Most recently, Ms. Eaton helped draft an amicus brief on behalf of 12 organizations in Whole Woman's Health v. Cole, a high-profile abortion rights case currently before the United States Supreme Court.

Ms. Eaton's pro bono efforts extend to representing individual pro bono clients as well such as an LGBT woman in an action alleging violations of city and state civil and human rights laws in connection with employment discrimination and a violent attack in a Sizzler Restaurant in Queens, New York and filing a U-Visa application on behalf of a pro bono client who fled Mexico after being subjected repeatedly to domestic violence at the hands of her former partner and the father of her children and based on her cooperation with law enforcement.

She has won numerous awards for her pro bono service including the Legal Aid Society's Pro Bono Publico Award five of the last six years in recognition of her exceptional service to the Legal Aid Society and its clients, and she was named as one of the New York Law Journal's Lawyers Who Lead By Example in 2015. Ms. Eaton also serves on the Board of Directors of the Children's Law Center of New York. For Ms. Eaton, providing legal services to the underprivileged while promoting social justice has been and continues to be one of the most rewarding aspects of her legal career. In addition to making life better for those who cannot otherwise afford to do soon their own, Ms. Eaton's experience working with and supervising other Willkie attorneys on pro bono matters has been incredibly rewarding.



Elaine K. Lou Associate, Ballard Spahr LLP

Under the Criminal Justice Act, Elaine Lou assisted in providing pro bono legal representation to indigent defendants in federal criminal cases appointed by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York. Ms. Lou has defended individual and corporate clients in criminal investigations brought by the U.S. Attorney's Offices for the Southern and Eastern Districts of New York and for the District of Connecticut, the New York County District Attorney's Office, and the U.S. Department of Justice Antitrust Division, and successfully advocated on behalf of these clients.

In addition, Ms. Lou is participating in the Clemency Project 2014 initiative, screening clemency petitions on behalf of the Project and representing individuals eligible for commutation under the Department of Justice program that seeks to reduce the sentences of long-term, non-violent federal offenders serving lengthy sentences under harsh and outdated laws. Ms. Lou is advocating on behalf of a woman who was 25 years old at the time of her arrest in the 1990s on drug conspiracy charges following her coerced participation in her then-boyfriend's drug distribution organization. The client was a first-time offender sentenced under the then-mandatory, harsh sentencing guidelines and has served over 18 years of a 30 year sentence, while certain of her equally or more culpable co-defendants have already been released. Ms. Lou was among the first to submit a petition on her client's behalf for commutation through Clemency Project 2014, which currently is pending before the Office of the Pardon Attorney, and remains hopeful that President Obama will grant her client clemency.

Ms. Lou also volunteers on a monthly basis with the New York City Bar Association's Monday Night Law Clinic, which provides consultations to individuals in the areas of housing, employment, family law, consumer law, small business and personal bankruptcy.

In 2015, Ms. Lou contributed 126 hours of pro bono legal services to these projects.

Ms. Lou is an associate at Ballard Spahr LLP. Her practice focuses on criminal and complex civil litigation, representing individual and corporate clients in criminal investigations. She has also represented individuals before the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority and other regulators.

Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP and affiliates strongly encourages its lawyers, summer associates, and legal assistants to do pro bono work for those individuals and groups unable to afford legal services. The firm is a charter signatory to the Law Firm Pro Bono Challenge, pledging to commit time equivalent to at least 3% of its annual billable hours to work on pro bono matters. In 2015, New York office lawyers and summer associates reached 4.6% of billable time. Firmwide, Skadden attorneys, summer associates, and legal assistants recorded 148,150 hours of pro bono legal work in 2015.

Deeply ingrained in the firm's culture, pro bono provides vital help to a wide variety of individuals and organizations in need of legal assistance. Skadden attorneys regularly assist those seeking asylum in the United States and elsewhere in their attempts to escape persecution due to religious or political beliefs or sexual orientation. Special counsel Steve Kolleeny was posthumously honored with a special award at the May 21st event, and with the Federal Bar Council's Thurgood Marshall Award for exceptional pro bono service on June 25. On November 9, 2015, Skadden was awarded The Legal Aid Society's 2015 Pro Bono Publico Award for Innovative Pro Bono Programming. The award recognized the Firm's initiation of three significant and unique pro bono programs that benefit both the Legal Aid and the clients we serve. On November 6, 2014, the Pro Bono Institute presented Skadden with the John H. Pickering Award in recognition of the Firm's "long-standing and remarkable commitment to pro bono."

Our Global Pro Bono Practice focuses on three areas: providing access to justice, promoting good governance and the rule of law, and serving the world's leading non-governmental organizations. More than 105 partners worldwide serve as Pro Bono Leaders who help guide and develop the practice, and lawyers from all of our offices do pro bono.

Pro bono is the centerpiece of our social responsibility initiative, which encompasses our legal education work – such as our sponsorship of the Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition – our volunteer programs, charitable contributions and Firm wide Green Initiative.

White & Case's integrated global footprint is distinctive and gives shape to our pro bono work. We offer many cross-border projects that provide all our lawyers the opportunity to work on international issues regardless of where they sit. Our largest project in 2015 involved researching the online sexual exploitation of children in 90 countries – in partnership with lawyers and legal staff from Goldman Sachs – to build a database for End Child Prostitution and Trafficking (ECPAT). More than 175 lawyers and legal staff across 20 offices participated in this global pro bono matter. Among other cross-office projects, we have also:

- Prepared an Arabic-language brochure to raise awareness among Syrian refugees about the importance of officially registering births and marriages with the government of the country to which they have fled to ensure legal protections. The brochures will be distributed to refugees in Jordan, Lebanon and Turkey.
- Supported the South Sudan peace process by examining the use of sanctions by regional authorities to promote peace or mitigate conflict and by advising on how to successfully design and implement national dialogues during peace processes.
- Researched the legal regimes in every country in the world to create a global database profiling the legal framework for children's rights in each country and its relationship to the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. The database will be used to highlight ways that national legal systems can be used to combat violations of children's rights.

In the United States and around the world, we have expanded our pro bono work on criminal matters, including death-penalty issues, LGBT rights, nature conservation, protecting the elderly, assisting leading NGOs with a range of corporate questions, preventing mass-atrocities, advancing animal rights, and guiding social entrepreneurs.

We believe that pro bono work is an excellent way to accelerate a young lawyer's training and development. All first year and summer associates are assigned at least one pro bono matter. We encourage all of our lawyers to propose pro bono matters to the Firm and to work at least 20 pro bono hours a year.

We go beyond talking about good citizenship at Hogan Lovells – we live it every day. We invest our time, talents, and resources in our communities and across the globe. We take the call to good citizenship seriously, and we're proud to see our collective dedication making a real difference in the lives of others.

We believe that everyone deserves meaningful access to justice, so we provide free legal services to people who need it most. Our lawyers devote more than 100,000 hours every year to pro bono matters, working together to bring about change.

In the last year alone, our New York lawyers have secured the safety of vulnerable and marginalized individuals seeking refuge in the United States; helped the elderly and chronically ill with advance planning needs; represented individuals under sentence of death seeking post-conviction review of their convictions and sentences; and worked with local nonprofits on bylaws and corporate governance policies that comply with the Nonprofit Revitalization Act.

We also achieved a significant victory for thousands of public housing tenants who suffer from asthma. In a class action against their landlord, the New York City Housing Authority, a federal judge agreed that NYCHA failed to take adequate steps to remediate mold in violation of a 2014 consent decree and granted our motion to appoint a special master to oversee NYCHA's efforts in the future. The case has attracted considerable public attention, given NYCHA's role as the city's largest landlord and the concurrent complaints over tenant safety, disaster preparedness, and budgetary management.

Hughes Hubbard & Reed considers its commitment to diversity and pro bono central to its mission. We encourage all of our attorneys to dedicate at least 50 hours to pro bono work each year, and they consistently exceed that number.

Immigration law has long been a principal component of Hughes Hubbard's pro bono program. Since 2005, Hughes Hubbard has taken sole responsibility for staffing The Legal Aid Society's weekly Immigration Detention Hotline, providing advice and counsel to the growing population of detained non-citizens across the New York City metropolitan area. Since 2006, Hughes Hubbard has worked with Immigration Equality to secure asylum for LGBT individuals fleeing persecution, and since 2012, the Firm has worked with KIND to represent unaccompanied and often abused immigrant children in the termination of removal proceedings and applications for DACA relief, asylum, Special Immigrant Juvenile Status, and green cards. In 2013, the Firm expanded partnerships with these organizations and others such as Her Justice and African Services Committee, allowing us to better advocate for the unique needs of children, abused women, and LGBT immigrant populations.

Another significant aspect of our pro bono practice is prisoner's rights. Since Hughes Hubbard partnered with Clemency Project 2014, the Firm has been helping non-violent drug offenders obtain the more lenient sentences they would have received if they were sentenced today. The Firm represents prisoners in federal court on section 1983 claims. Recent cases have involved individuals who were denied adequate medical treatment while incarcerated and excessive force cases. In August, 2015, the Firm secured the release of a man who, wrongfully convicted of murder in 1993, had spent more than 23 years in prison. This month, the firm filed an amicus brief in the South Carolina Supreme Court on behalf of the Arc of South Carolina, Able SC, the South Carolina chapter of the American Association on Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities, Protection and Advocacy for People with Disabilities, Inc. and Family Connection of South Carolina in involving a former death row inmate with intellectual disabilities.
