1. I am associated with the firm of _____, attorneys for defendant _____. I am personally familiar with the facts herein and submit this affidavit in support of the defendant's motion pursuant to CPLR 7503(a) and 2201 for an order (a) compelling plaintiff to arbitrate his claims against the defendant and (b) staying this litigation in its entirety pending resolution of such arbitration.
