## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

### WOMEN ON THE MOVE

#### *Talking While Female*

The Women on the Move program is a Continuing Legal Education seminar focusing on an array of topics of particular interest to women attorneys. This year's program theme is Talking While Female. Distinguished panelists and speakers will share their experiences and valuable insights.

This year's program hopes to address issues and practical skills to call out the unconscious bias women often face in communications and the difficult conversations with colleagues, clients and others that can follow. Not being fully heard above the fray can stop the progression of one's career, undermine solid legal arguments, or cause clients to lose faith in a lawyer's abilities. This is particularly true for female attorneys who might be faced with hurdles in communications based on sex or age, whether by misguided gender ideas or outright discrimination. Our panel of experts will provide information and strategies on how to effectively communicate and persuasively face these issues.

This year's program will be held in Westchester, New York at the Larchmont Shore Club on Thursday, October 26, 2017 and will feature a keynote address by Ona T. Wang, Esq.
