

Preet Bharara, Esq.



Preet Bharara served as U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York from 2009 to 2017, where he oversaw the investigation and litigation of all criminal and civil cases in an eight-county area. Bharara supervised an office of more than 200 Assistant U.S. Attorneys, who handled cases involving domestic and international terrorism, narcotics and arms trafficking, financial and health care fraud, cybercrime, public corruption, gang violence, organized crime and civil rights violations. *The New York Times* noted that Bharara was considered "one of the most aggressive and outspoken prosecutors of public corruption and Wall Street crime in the United States."

In 2017, Bharara joined the New York University School of Law faculty as a Distinguished Scholar in Residence. He is the executive vice president of Some Spider Studios and the host of CAFE's *Stay Tuned with Preet*, a podcast focused on issues of justice and fairness. Bharara graduated magna cum laude from Harvard College and earned his law degree from Columbia Law School, where he was a member of the *Columbia Law Review*.
