This 5-day trial techniques program will teach, advance and improve the courtroom skills of young attorneys and lawyers who want to improve their litigation skills with an emphasis on direct participation.

Under New York's MCLE rule, this program has been approved for a total of 37.5 credit hours; 2.0 credits in Ethics and 35.5 credits in Practical Skills. This program is transitional and therefore suitable for newly-admitted attorneys.

The scholarship covers the recipient's registration fee. The awardee must provide for his or her own room, board, and travel expenses, although some meals and receptions are included at the Trial Academy.

The article may also focus on substantive law, case law or criminal law procedure topic that you would like to share and provide as a benefit to the section members.

The scholarship is offered to any member of the New York State Bar Association. Applicants are not required to be a member of the Criminal Justice Section, however, recipients will be asked to join. It will be awarded to a deserving attorney to honor Jack Litman, Esq., an esteemed member of the Criminal Justice Section for many years.
