Under New York's MCLE rule, this program has been approved for a total of 37.5 credit hours; 2.0 credits in Ethics and 35.5 credits in Practical Skills. This program is transitional and therefore suitable for newly-admitted attorneys.

The program will take place at Cornell Law School. The New York State Bar Association Trial Academy is a five-day trial techniques program that will teach, advance and improve the courtroom skills of young and new lawyers with an emphasis on direct participation. For more information go to
