

# 2020 Minority Fellowship in Environmental & Energy Law

# Sponsored by New York State Bar Association Environmental & Energy Law Section

### **The Fellowship**

- \$7,500 stipend to spend the summer of 2020 (8 weeks minimum) working on legal matters for a government environmental or energy agency or public interest environmental organization in New York State. (The applicant need not have identified a summer internship prior to applying for the fellowship. After a 2020 fellowship awardee has been selected, members of the Section can assist the awardee in searching for a summer internship placement.)
- Invitation to the annual meeting of the NYSBA's Environmental & Energy Law Section
- —— Assignment of a mentor from the environmental or energy bar

### **Eligibility**

First-year, second-year, and third-year (night students only) minority group members who are: 1) enrolled in a law school in New York State; or 2) permanent New York State residents, and enrolled in a law school in the United States. Minority group members are persons who are: African American, Latino, Native American, Alaskan native, Asian or Pacific Islander.

All applicants must be a member of NYSBA and the Environmental & Energy Law Section. A Law Student Application is attached. Membership is free for law students.

### **Fellowship Criteria**

Interest in environmental or energy issues; strong academic record (undergraduate and/or law school); outstanding personal qualities; leadership abilities; financial need. (A law school course in environmental or energy law is <u>not</u> a prerequisite.)

### **Application Requirements**

Applications must contain a completed application form; a resume; an undergraduate transcript; a law school transcript (except for first-year law students); an essay describing applicant's interest in environmental or energy issues and reasons for wanting to participate in the Fellowship; and two letters of recommendation.

### **Application Deadline**

- 3. An essay (maximum: two double-spaced typewritten pages) describing your interest in environmental or energy issues, your personal qualities and leadership ability, and reasons for wanting to participate in the Fellowship.
- 4. Information about your financial need.
- 5. Two letters of recommendation. (These may be the same as used for law school applications. If these letters are confidential, they may be sent directly to the Fellowship Committee at address below.)
