This letter and enclosures are being forwarded to you in connection with the "New York State Climate Action Plan Interim Report" issued by the New York State Climate Action Council for which public input was requested.

The New York State Bar Association ("NYSBA") appointed a Task Force on Global Warming to make specific proposals that the State could implement in a timely and cost-effective manner to address the impacts of climate change. The Task Force completed a report, entitled *Taking Action in New York on Climate Change* (January 2009), which contained a series of recommendations that could be implemented.
