Qualifications for Admittees

To qualify for admission to the Bar of the United States Supreme Court, an applicant must have been admitted to practice in the highest court of a State, Commonwealth, Territory or Possession, or the District of Columbia for a period of at least three years immediately before the date of application; must not have been the subject of an adverse disciplinary action pronounced or in effect during that 3-year period; and must appear to the Court to be of good moral and professional character.

After you submit your pre-registration form **(due no later than May 1, 2019)** and appropriate pre-registration fee(s), you will receive, in June 2019, a complete packet of instructions, formal application form, personal history sheet and list of sponsors in your area with whom you may choose to meet. If you know of other U.S. Supreme Court admittees (not on the list provided) who are willing to serve as your sponsor(s), please feel free to contact them directly.

Supreme Court Fee

Pre-registration fee **does not** include the Supreme Court admission fee of \$200. This fee is due with your application, **no later than August 15, 2019**.

Please note: Registration fees do not include hotel accommodations. Reservations must be made directly with The Hyatt Regency on Capitol Hill.

Guests at the Supreme Court Admissions Ceremony

It is a rule of the United States Supreme Court that <u>only one guest per admittee will be allowed into the</u> <u>courtroom</u> to observe the ceremony. This policy is strictly enforced. Electronic devices, purses, bags or backpacks are absolutely <u>not</u> allowed. Should you bring a camera, you will be required to leave it in the holding room during the ceremony. Children under six years of age will not be admitted in the courtroom.

Those who are not staying at The Hyatt Regency must plan to arrive at the United States Supreme Court no later than 7:55 am on Monday morning.
