ATTORNEY REGISTRATION/AFFIRMATION

The rules of the Appellate Division, Second Department, Section 691.12, have been amended to include with the biennial registration an affirmation of compliance with DR 9-102 of the Lawyer's Code of Professional Responsibility. Such affirmation will be available at all times to the Grievance Committees. DR 9-102 governs the fiduciary responsibility of practicing attorneys with regard to depositing clients' funds in separate accounts.
