CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

he New York State Bar Association is pleased to announce that nominations are being accepted for the 2016 Kay Crawford Murray Award. In 2008, the Committee on

Women in the Law created the Kay Crawford Murray Award in honor of the professional and personal commitment Ms. Murray has made to supporting and advancing the legal careers of women, particularly African American women attorneys. The award honors a member of the bar who recognizes the value of diversity in the legal profession and who has dedicated her or his time to advancing the professional development of women attorneys.

Kay Crawford Murray received the New York State Bar Association's inaugural Kay Crawford Murray Award during the NYSBA's annual meeting in 2008. The award, which is presented by the NYSBA Committee on Women in the Law, celebrates an individual who, in the spirit of Ms. Murray, recognizes the value of diversity in the legal profession and has committed to advancing the professional development of women attorneys. During the time Ms. Murray chaired the committee, she raised awareness of women's issues, spearheading a report that urged the Association to propose a model policy for childbirth and parenting as a guideline for law firms.

"Kay embodies the ideals that we as members of the New York State Bar Association strive for. She is a strong advocate of diversity and mentoring the careers of women attorneys," said Ellen Makofsky, co-chair of the NYSBA's Committee on Women in the Law. Co-chair Ferve Ozturk added that, "Promoting diversity is a key mission for the Committee on Women in the Law. Through the Kay Crawford Murray award, we strive to recognize attorneys who are meaningfully advancing diversity and enhancing women's development in the legal profession."

When submitting nominations for this award and in the spirit of the diversity efforts of Kay Crawford Murray, everyone is encouraged to keep in mind the 2003 diversity policy of the Association: "Diversity is an inclusive concept, encompassing gender, race, color, ethnic origin, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, age and disability."

Recent recipients include Karen E. Simmons in 2015, Connie O. Walker in 2014, Hon. Sondra Miller in 2013, and Hon. Jenny Rivera in 2010.

The Kay Crawford Murray Award will be presented at the Committee on Women in the Law Luncheon on January 25, 2016 in New York City. It is mandatory that the award recipient be present at the luncheon to receive the award in person.

To allow for adequate time for review, nominations must be received by **November 2, 2015**.
