

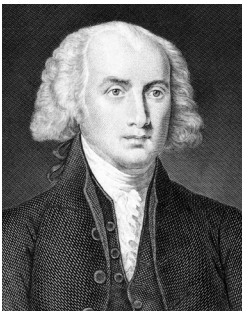


James Madison Legacy Project
